Condition	Cause	Antibiotics Needed?	
Strep throat	😥 Bacteria		<b>Yes</b> . Antibiotics can only treat bacterial infections and may be prescribed by your healthcare provider.
Whooping cough	😥 Bacteria		
Urinary Tract Infection	🔅 Bacteria		
Sinus Infection	🔅 Bacteria or Virus 🗞	?	<b>Maybe</b> . Your provider can tell if an antibiotic will help.
Middle Ear Infection	🔅 Bacteria or Virus 🗞		
Bronchitis/Chest Cold (in otherwise healthy children and adults)*	😥 Bacteria or Virus 🗞		<b>No</b> . Bronchitis is rarely caused by bacteria.
Common Cold/Runny Nose	Virus		<b>No</b> . Viral infections won't respond to antibiotics. Ask your provider how to treat your symptoms.
Sore Throat (except strep)	Virus		
Flu	Virus		

Antibiotics are a great tool against bacterial infection.
